Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security Number and Investment Experience
- Income and Account Transactions
- Assets and Investment Objectives

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons **TSP Financial, LLC** chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does Bleakley protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

We maintain safeguards that comply with federal standards to protect nonpublic personal information of our customers, including procedures to assure appropriate access to, and use of, information about our customers.

How does Bleakley collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Seek advice about your investments or Enter into an investment advisory contract
- Show your driver's license or Give us your contact information
- Tell us about your investment or retirement portfolio

We may also collect your personal information from nonaffiliates. See below for more information.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more information.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- TSP Financial, LLC has no affiliates.

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- TSP Financial, LLC's nonaffiliates include custodians, third-party investment managers, and broker-dealers.

Joint Marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- TSP Financial, LLC does not jointly market with nonaffiliates.

Other important information

Nonaffiliates: We will share your information with nonaffiliates as necessary to service your account(s) including, without limitation, the settlement, billing, processing, clearing, and/or transferring of transactions.

State Laws: We will automatically limit sharing of your information in accordance with applicable state law.
